Domaine La Barbotaine Sancerre , France, 2022 <i>Vegan</i> <i>Classic lemon, cut grass and fresh asparagus nose, fresh high acidity and great mineral elegance makes this low volume, family made, hand cared for Sancerre stand out from the crowd.</i>			60

<p>Woodstock, Deep Sands, Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia, 2021</p> <p><i>Deep Sands Shiraz is a full bodied, ripe red from the historic Woodstock Estate in the Blewitt Springs area of South Australian wine region McLaren Vale, which is characterised by its sandy soils. Flavours of sweet dark plum, blackberry and spices with soft tannins.</i></p>	13	17	49
<p>Château Notre Dame Montagne Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux, France, 2018 <i>Vegan</i></p> <p><i>A blend of Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Montagne St Emilion is the source of some of the Right Bank's best value wines, and the Notre Dame has lovely full-bodied, juicy plum and blackberry fruit with hints of spice, coffee bean and leather, with ripe meaty tannins rounding out the palate.</i></p>	14.5	18	52
<p>Château de Manissy Lirac Traditionnel, Southern Rhône, France, 2020 <i>Organic Vegan</i></p> <p><i>This wine has a powerful smell with aromas of eucalyptus, black fruits and toasted notes. It's around and concentrated wine, with a nice balance of spice and fruit, a woody nuance and good length.</i></p>			54
<p>Bodegas Ochoa Reserva, Navarra, Spain, 2015</p> <p><i>An elegant classic style of wine, round and complex, with a high level of tannins and the necessary time in barrel and bottle (minimum 3 years). Every year the finest Tempranillo, Merlot and Cabernet are selected in the vineyards to create this high quality wine.</i></p>			59
<p>Blackenbrook Family Reserve Pinot Noir, Nelson, New Zealand, 2019</p> <p><i>Enticing nose of stewed raspberry, wild cherry, mulberry and pepper; good breadth with impressive weight and ripe, grainy tannins. Still quite primary and youthful, but grows in complexity with complex meaty notes appearing in the glass.</i></p>			67
<p>Metzer Shiraz, Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2018 <i>Vegan</i></p> <p><i>The wine shows pronounced floral notes backed up by white pepper, blackberries and violets as well as a hint of olive. Notes of dried flowers are folded into the background. The palate is powerful yet graceful featuring ripe fruit complemented by savoury notes which keeps the wine balanced.</i></p>			73
<p>Althorne Estate Pinot Noir, Crouch River, Essex, 2020</p> <p><i>Lots of deliciousness! It tastes surprisingly like Burgundy. It's lovely, smooth and interesting. It's just so wonderful that it comes from England. The tannins are really easy. The acidity is not too high.</i></p>			75
<p>Paolo Manzone Barolo DOCG Serralunga, Piedmont, Italy, 2019 <i>Vegan</i></p> <p><i>Perfumed notes of roses, maraschino cherry, damson and a touch of blackberry with gamey notes emerging with air. Ripe, fine tannins and poised, balanced acidity. Classically constructed yet approachable.</i></p>			90
<p>Val di Suga Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy, 2016</p> <p><i>On the nose the wine offers up complex aromas of roasted plum, dark cherry, truffle, wild herbs and roasted meats, while the palate is full yet structured with ripe, firm tannins and excellent length. In its element with rich food, this powerful, expressive wine mellows after time in a decanter or glass.</i></p>			99
<p>Cuvelier Los Andes Grand Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2016 <i>Vegan</i></p> <p><i>Ripe black cherries, blackberries, liqueur de cassis and plum jam flavours with notes of sweet spices, Belgian chocolate, vanilla and cinnamon. It is lush, dense, with glossy tannins, masses of dry extract, penetrating flavours and a very long finish.</i></p>			130
<p>Domaine Chantal Lescure Pommard 1er cru 'Les Bertins', France, 2015 <i>Vegan</i></p> <p><i>Chantal Lescure Pommard 1er Cru Les Bertins 2015 is organic Pinot Noir from vines on the south, Volnay side of Pommard at the foot of the hills. From ripe 2015, this has rich, blackberry fruit and ripe tannins.</i></p>
